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# \$50,000

Can provide 50 Alumni with dedicated GWI Alumni Career Institute services and programming, including but not limited to career advising, mentorship, leadership opportunities, a digital career portal, and an annual Alumni Conference.

#### \$25,000

Can sponsor the participation of a GWI Scholar in our industry-leading 4-week technical training at the Wharton School, including faculty, room & board, as part of our flagship Summer Intensive Program. All scholars are placed in a guaranteed 7-week paid frontline investing internship, and paired with an industry mentor for the summer.

#### \$10,000

Can provide a GWI Alumni with a scholarship to participate in GWI's new pilot, Investor Leadership Program (ILP). ILP is an inaugural in-residence program designed to proactively address the retention cliffs by focusing on serving GWI Alumni and non-GWI women/non-binary peers in Investment Management who are an average of 4 years into their careers.

#### \$5,000

Can provide a GWI scholar with need-based financial assistance to support out-of-pocket summer expenses, such as travel and short-term housing, and to offset the loss in earnings during the 4-week educational training - helping eliminate barriers to program participation.

#### \$50,000

Provides for expanding and increasing access to Smart Kids with LD online resources by updating our technology, redesigning the website, and producing content on the digital platforms where young families look for information on their children's struggles with learning and attention issues.

#### \$25,000

Develops online training for Countdown to Kindergarten, a research-based program that teaches at-risk preschoolers in underserved communities the early literacy and social-emotional skills needed to start school, via a partnership with Head Start.

#### \$10,000

Supports expanding access to the annual Smart Kids with LD Parent Conference to make the indepth information by leading experts available to parents, educators and professionals across the country, through enhancing electronic and inperson access to sessions.

#### \$5,000

Helps establish a pilot parent-to-parent mentoring program, training volunteer mentors to provide information, resources, and emotional support via one-on-one sessions for parents who need help navigating the special education system.

#### \$50,000

Provides tuition gap assistance for private high school placement outside of Newburgh. The San Miguel Graduate Success Program provides financial support to all San Miguel Academy graduates in secondary programs. The Graduate Success Program also provides multiple services for the continued growth and development of our students including guidance through the college process and other post-secondary options, test preparation, tutoring, mentoring, wellness support, career counseling, and assistance with internship placement.

#### \$25,000

Transportation fees to sustain place-based learning for one year. Our Project and Place-Based Learning Program, developed by San Miguel Academy staff, is an interactive STEAM-focused approach that facilitates inquiry and investigation and actively promotes career-ready skill development.

#### \$10,000

One week of full-day summer program. The San Miguel Summer Program extends the school year into the summer months and provides continued intensive academic tutoring and diverse STEAM-focused learning, ranging from robotics to aviation.

### \$5,000

Upgrade security cameras. Enhancing the security of our facility is critical to the safety of our middle school students. While Newburgh continues to be plagued by a culture of violence and lawlessness, it is our priority to provide our students with a safe and positive learning environment.
